REIS and Formas



- Individual grants vs "organization grants"
- Organization grants: A few such as Smart Built Environment, Centers for sustainable and competitive foodsystems
- Support for individual researchers:
 Prisma support, successful applications on demand, budget support (limited!)
- Contact person: Henrik Aspeborg





- Formulate their own research questions based on societal challenges within Formas' areas of responsibility
- Formas' three areas of responsibility; environment, agricultural sciences and spatial planning
- Inter- and transdisciplinary research questions are welcome
- Maximum of 3 years and a total of 3 million SEK
- Early career: Maximum of 4 years and a total of 4 million SEK
- Success rate 2020 13%
- Research projects for early-career researchers
 - doctoral degree, diploma issued, no earlier than January 1, 2013 and no later than December 31, 2019.

Formas – SRC performance (Annual call)



- 2020
 - Research grant: 4 (total 16 SU)
 - Early-career: 2 (total 6 SU)
 - Mobility: 1 (total 3 SU)
- 2019
 - Research grant: 3 (total 11 SU)
 - Early-career: 1 (total 6 SU)
 - Mobility: 2 (total 4 SU)
- 2018
 - Research grant: 1 (total 10 SU)
 - Early-career: 0 (total 5 SU)
 - Mobility: 0 (total 6 SU)

Assessment criteria



Criteria for scientific quality

- Research question
- Scientific competence
- Method and performance

Criteria for societal relevance

- Potential societal value of the research topic
- Communication with stakeholders and users

Formas - Practical advice



- Read instructions carefully
- Put time and effort into the societal relevance, short and long term perspective
- Realistic project and realistic communication plan
- Create a reference group
- Ask colleagues for feedback
